Contest Information

Grades K-2 Coloring Contest:

Standard-size "9 X 12" white card stock paper, must be colored within the lines of the picture provided

Grades 3-5 Coloring Contest:

Standard size "9 X 12" white card stock paper, must be colored within the lines of the picture provided

Grades 6-8

Poster shall be "18 x 24" poster board. Posters may be drawn vertically or horizontally. Posters shall reflect the Fire Prevention theme: "Stop Drop and Rock N Roll"

Special Education Students Kindergarten through 8th grade

Standard size "9 X 12" white card stock paper, must be colored within the lines of either picture provided. Option is to create a poster, shall be "18 x 24" poster board. Posters shall reflect the Fire Prevention theme: "Stop Drop and Rock N Roll"

All entries:

Back of the poster should include: child's name, teacher's name, grade, school, parents name and contact number. Entries must be delivered to the Silverton Fire Company, 15 Kettle Creek Road by Friday, October 14, 2011 at 3pm. We will attempt to display all posters during the Fall Festival in our Fire Hall, which will be Saturday, October 15, 2011.

Contest winners will be selected from each contest listed above with one grand prize winner. The Grand Prize winner's poster will be on the Silverton Fire Company's Web Site and that child will receive a ride to school on a fire truck along with their prize. Winning posters in each grade will be displayed in the fire station. 2nd place and honorable mentions will be selected and awarded a prize.
